

OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS
OF THE COMMON COUNCIL
Regular Meeting

South Milwaukee
April 7, 2021

The Regular Meeting of the Common Council was called to order by Mayor Brooks at 7:00 p.m. On roll, all were present.

The meeting was prefaced by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Bartoshevich indicated that item four should be deleted from the agenda.

Under President of the Council, Bartoshevich/Clark moved to adopt the items in the consent agenda: a) approval of minutes from the March 16, 2021 Common Council meeting and b) approval of the Schedule of Vouchers for the period ending March 31, 2021 in the amount of \$2,198,918.44 and c) Approval of the financial reports for the various funds for December, 2020, and January and February, 2021. All voted aye, motion carried.

Under Human Resources Committee, Clark/Bartoshevich moved to accept Water Utility Lab Technician/Operator Darryl Gabriel's letter of retirement effective May 31, 2021, with regrets. All voted aye, motion carried.

Under Legislation & Permits Committee, Pieper/Clark moved to approve the ordinance to amend Chapter 5 of the Municipal Code pertaining to Administrative Affairs and give it its first reading and refer it back to Legislation & Permits Committee for further review. All voted aye, motion carried.

Under Public Works & Public Property, Bartoshevich/Clark moved to authorize the proper city officials to execute a contract for Michigan Avenue (12th to 15th) Reconstruction, Part A (Sanitary and Storm Sewer) with American Sewer Services, Inc. in a base contract amount of \$228,082.00 with funding from Storm Water Utility and Sewer Enterprise Funds. On roll, all voted aye. Motion carried.

Bartoshevich/Clark moved to authorize the proper city officials to execute a contract for Michigan Avenue (12th to 15th), Part B (Roadway Reconstruction) with Payne and Dolan, Inc. in a base contact amount of \$327,159.20 with funding from account 700-00000-59109, Michigan Avenue, and Storm Water Utility Capital. On roll call, all voted aye. Motion carried.

Bartoshevich/Clark, moved to authorize the proper city officials to execute a contract for Bucyrus Club Parking Lot Paving with Wolf Paving Co., Inc. for the amount of \$66,125.00 with funding from account 950-00000-58440. On roll, all voted aye except Pieper who voted no. Motion carried.

Under Plan Commission, Briesemeister reminded Council that the next meeting of the Plan Commission is scheduled for April 27, 2021 at 6:30 p.m.

Under Reports of the Mayor, Bartoshevich/Clark moved to adopt Resolution No. 21-08 advocating support for a strong State and Local Partnership for Shared Revenue Funds Critical Services. All voted aye, motion carried.

Bartoshevich/Clark moved to receive and place on file, the South Milwaukee Police Department 2020 Annual Report. All voted aye, motion carried.

Under Miscellaneous Business, City Administrator Mayzik gave an update regarding filling the upcoming Water Superintendent vacancy. The will combine the position with the Wastewater Superintendent on a trial basis.

Mayzik gave an update regarding the American Rescue Plan Act funding.

Discussion was had on events/possible events in the city. Currently, applications will be determined on a case by case basis and the matter will be revisited at a later meeting.

Pieper moved to not approve a Resolution Supporting mask-wearing as an important measure to limit the spread of the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19). Motion failed for lack of a second.

Bartoshevich/Clark moved to adopt Resolution No. 21-08 supporting mask-wearing as an important measure to limit the spread of the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19). On roll, Bartoshevich, Clark, Bukowski, Briesemeister and Maass voted aye. Navarro, Stoner and Pieper voted no. Motion carried.

There being no further business to discuss, Stoner/Navarro moved to adjourn at 9:13 p.m. All voted aye, motion carried.
